The successful candidate must have experience as an administrator, excellent communication skills, unquestionable integrity and be willing to be involved in the community. The Board will offer a competitive compensation package to the successful candidate with an **annual base salary range of \$101,000 to \$116,000** plus benefits. **Housing is available**.



The District

The lone SD is a **public charter** school district which serves approximately 150 students in grades K-12 in one K-6 elementary school and one 7-12 middle/high school. The district employs a staff of 17 licensed staff; 12 classified staff; one confidential staff; and two administrative staff. The district has one active bond project and operates with a general fund budget of approximately \$4.0 million. The District provides iPads for each student in grades 6-12 and iPad labs for students in grades K-5. As a part of the facilities, lone SD has an outdoor heated pool and provides elementary students lessons in the fall and spring. The Eastern Promise program offers over 50 college credits each year for high school students. The music program of choral and instrumental performances is available for students in grades K through 12.

Route 74 forms part of the Blue Mountain Scenic Byway, a 130-mile set of roads connecting I-84 along the Columbia River with the North Fork John Day River in the Blue Mountains. Part of the route follows the Willow Creek drainage through lone. The historic Oregon Trail crosses nearby at Well Springs.
