The Sweet Home School District Board of Directors is seeking a highly qualified candidate with visionary leadership skills and successful experience in education administration to serve as superintendent. The Sweet Home School District comprises approximately 2,100 students in seven schools, four elementary, one charter elementary, one junior high school and one high school. The district employs a staff of 140 licensed employees, 190 classified employees, two confidential employees and 13 administrators. The district has a total budget of approximately \$27.5 million and a bond.

Sweet Home is located in the Cascade Mountain foothills, stretching from the Willamette Valley to the summit of the Cascade Mountains and has a population of approximately 10,000 people. The area is known for numerous recreational activities which include boating, fishing, swimming and hiking.

The board will offer a competitive compensation package to the successful candidate. The salary range is \$135,000 to \$150,000. The successful candidate must hold or qualify for an Oregon superintendent's license.
