

The Woodburn SD serves approximately 5

approximately 5,500 students in four elementary, two middle and five small high schools (consisting of 4 small academies and one alternative high school). The District employs a staff of 277 licensed employees, 321 classified employees, eight confidential employees, and 40 administrators. Woodburn SD has a general fund budget of \$80 million and passed a capital improvement bond of \$61.5M in 2015. In 2019 both the Boys and Girls soccer teams were 4A State Champions.


