The Arco Iris Spanish Immersion School (a public charter school) is seeking applicants for the Executive Director position to begin work on July 1, 2022. The Arco Iris School Executive Director is responsible for the successful operation and management of the school, including curriculum, instruction, staff, budget, physical facilities, public relations and the safety and welfare of the students and staff. The School will offer a competitive compensation package to the successful candidate with an annual base salary range of \$110,000 - \$120,000 plus benefits which includes picking up the employee's contribution to PERS which is 6% of salary.

The Executive Director supports the teachers in developing students into responsible, bilingual, bi-literate and multi-culturally competent members of the community.





The School

Arco Iris Spanish Immersion School is a K-8th grade public charter school in Beaverton.



Oregon, featuring Spanish immersion and Singapore Math serving approximately 400 students. The School employs a staff of ten classified staff, 23 licensed staff and two administrative staff.

The School founded in 2010 is the first charter school in the Beaverton School District. Arco Iris School is a one-way Spanish Immersion school with a mission focused on bilingual language achievement, a rigorous mathematics program and a multicultural community that will improve outcomes for all students, including those who are historically and educationally underserved. Students also have daily English class and with the double emphasis on language arts.

The students usually score in the top 10% in the state every year. For 2021, the School was ranked #3 for Best Charter Elementary Schools in Oregon, #4 for Best Charter Middle Schools in Oregon and #15 for Best Public Middle Schools in Oregon by Niche.com with an overall grade of "A".
