

The Board will offer a competitive compensation package to the successful candidate with an **annual salary range of \$145,000 to \$165,000 plus benefits**.



#### The District

The Morrow County SD serves about **2,200** 



students in nine schools. One K-3 elementary school, one 4-6 elementary school and one 7-12 middle/high school in Boardman. One K-3 elementary school, one 4-6 elementary school, one 7-12 middle/high school and one alternative school in Irrigon, one K-6 elementary school, and one 7-12 middle/high school in Heppner. The District employs a staff of 149 licensed employees, 127 classified employees, six confidential employees, and 16 administrators. The District has a general fund budget of approximately \$79.5 million. The School District includes the communities of Boardman. Irrigon and Heppner. Covering 2,000 square miles, the District has two central offices, one located in Irrigon and one located in Heppner.
