Dufur School District serves approximately 360 students in **one K-12 public school**. The District employs a staff of 29 licensed employees, 30 classified employees, 3 confidential employees, and 2 administrators. The District has a general fund budget of about \$6.65 million and a capital improvement bond **of \$4 million passed in 2018**

The District has a strong career and technical education program, a vibrant Agricultural Education program and dual credit options.

The District has two endowment funds. The Jerri Walker DePriest Endowment Fund was established in 1997 and has nearly \$2.5 million. It provides scholarships to Dufur graduates. The Ranger Pride Education Foundation has nearly \$2.3 million and provides scholarships as well as education supports for K-12. The RPEF has developed funds to endow teaching positions in the Dufur School District.
